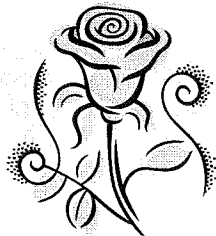

On February 10, 2011, the Sigma Zeta college chapter of SAI initiated Kevin Woelfel, director of the University of Idaho's Lionel Hampton School of Music, as a Friend of the Arts. This category of distinguished membership in Sigma Alpha Iota recognizes his diverse achievements in the music industry as a performer, composer, designer and manufacturer, music administrator, and a nationally acclaimed lecturer on musical entrepreneurship—as well as for his support of our activities on campus.

The Moscow-Pullman Alumnae Chapter of Sigma Alpha Iota was chartered on October 28, 1961. The chapter currently has over 20 members, representing music schools from many regions of the United States. Like the national fraternity, members of this alumnae chapter are dedicated to the philanthropic support of musical activities both at the national and local levels, and are active in musical service to the community. In past years the chapter's philanthropy has included gifts of dictionaries, recordings of American music, opera videos and a VCR/DVD player for the School of Music's library, and a monetary award for an outstanding college member of S.A.I.

Contributions received at this annual fundraising event enable the chapter to give an award to an outstanding college SAI member, and to provide grant money to community music groups. In recent years, this Musical Outreach Grant for the Greater Palouse Region has been awarded to the Moscow Arts Commission for Farmer's Market Musicians, Moscow Community Theatre, Moscow Charter School musical theatre production and to the UI Music Education program for the purchase of Orff percussion instruments. In 2009 the grant was awarded to the Palouse Suzuki Strings organization in support of student scholarships. Today's program features two performing groups from that organization.
