REQUIREMENTS FOR THIS AWARD:

- Each applicant must be a member “in good standing” with the Sigma Zeta College Chapter, and with the national fraternity.
- She must be active in chapter meetings and chapter projects.
- She must be a member of Sigma Zeta for two full semesters (not including initiating semester) before she can apply for this award.
- The applicant must state her intention to continue her studies at the University of Idaho, and her plan to remain active in the Sigma Zeta Chapter.

A check for **\$200** will be presented to the award recipient in January.

We expect that the recipient of this award will continue her exemplary participation and leadership in Sigma Zeta Chapter activities during the following year.

We invite her to perform on the alumnae chapter’s annual musicale.

REQUIREMENTS:

The following requirements must be met by each Sigma Zeta Chapter member who applies for the award:

1. The applicant must be a member of the Sigma Zeta college chapter and be in good standing with the Sigma Alpha Iota National Executive Office.
2. The applicant must be active in chapter meetings and chapter projects.
3. She must be a member of Sigma Zeta for two full semesters (not including initiating semester) before she can apply for this award.
4. At the time of her application, the applicant must state her intention to continue her studies at the University of Idaho, and to remain active in the Sigma Zeta Chapter.
5. It is expected that the recipient of this award will continue her exemplary participation and leadership in Sigma Zeta Chapter activities during the year following the receipt of the monetary award.

The award recipient will be announced at the Moscow-Pullman Alumnae meeting in January. The money will be presented to the recipient at a later date. The recipient is encouraged to perform for an alumnae meeting and/or on the next Alumnae Musicale program.
